Thank you for coming. We're glad you're here! Our typical order of service is Welcome and opening prayer; worship through music; worship through God's Word (sermon); worship through prayer and giving; and closing prayer.

We offer two services: 8:30 am and 10 am, with distancing between family units at both services. The 10 am service is live streamed at faith-family.org and on our Facebook page.

Children who are toddlers through fifth graders will meet in their classrooms during the 10 am service. The service is available to watch live on the TV in the nursery suite.
