Thank you for coming. We're glad you're here! Our typical order of service is worship through music and prayer, worship through God's Word (sermon), worship through giving, and closing prayer. Assistive Listening devices are available; let an usher know if you would like use them.

We offer one Sunday worship service at 9:30 am during June, July, and August. Our two-service schedule will resume September 4. Our service is live streamed at [faith-family.org](http://faith-family.org) and on our Facebook page.

Infants through pre-k children meet in their classrooms during the entire service. Kindergarten through 5th grade students stay with their families until they are dismissed, at about 10 am.

1. A \_\_\_\_\_ Sinner (vs. 37-38)
  - Her love for Christ was on display, expressed in \_\_\_\_\_ devotion to Jesus.
  
2. A \_\_\_\_\_ Host (vs. 39)
  - Simon is blind to the reality Jesus’s teachings had little to do with the accumulative \_\_\_\_\_ of sin, instead had everything to do with the \_\_\_\_\_ of sin.
  
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ Savior (vs 40 – 50)
  - SOZO (sode-zoe) – To Give \_\_\_\_\_ Life
  - Jesus’s words of forgiveness weren’t cheap; it would literally cost him his life.
