Free coffee is available in the Journey Room behind the Worship Center, as well as other food and beverage items which are for sale. Assistive Listening devices are available; let an usher know if you would like use them.

Our 10 am service is live streamed at [faith-family.org](http://faith-family.org) and on our Facebook page. Infants through pre-k children meet in their classrooms during the entire 10 am service. Kindergarten through 5th grade students stay with their families until they are dismissed, at about 10:30 am.
