God is Elohim.

Genesis 1:1

Five realities we learn about Elohim from the creation account:

Hebrews 10:12 (Christ rested; ceased His activity)

Hebrews 4:1-3a (Believers rest; cease their activity)

He created	(Hebrews 11:3)
He establishes	_ out of chaos. (1 Corinthians 14:33)
He displays His	_ through people. (Genesis 1:26)
He made a world that	itself. (Genesis 1:28)
He rested on the	SEVENTH DAY. (Genesis 2:2)

From the creation account, God (Elohim) reveals Himself to us in five profound ways.

Have you personally experienced God in these five ways?
