Thank you for coming. We're glad you're here! Although today is somewhat different, our typical order of service is worship through music and prayer, worship through God's Word (sermon), worship through giving, and closing prayer. Communion elements are gluten free.

Our usual Sunday Services are at 8:30 am and at 10 am. The 10 am service is live streamed on YouTube @FaithFamilyChurchFayetteMO and on our website.

Infants through pre-k children meet in their classrooms during the entire 10 am service. Kindergarten through fifth grade students stay with their families until they are dismissed, at about 10:30 am. Children stay with their families during the 8:30 am service.
