Our Sunday Services are at 8:30 am and at 10 am. The 10 am service is live streamed on our website and on YouTube @FaithFamilyChurchFayetteMO. **Beginning Sunday, May 26, we will switch to our summer Sunday morning schedule, which is one service at 9:30 am.**

Infants through pre-k children meet in their classrooms during the entire 10 am service. Kindergarten through fifth grade students stay with their families until they are dismissed, at about 10:30 am. Children stay with their families during the 8:30 am service.
