2 Thessalonians 2:1-15

Paul clarifies and comforts.

"... we will be gathered to meet Him." (v 1b)

"Don't be so easily shaken in mind or troubled ..." (v 2a)

Two signs marking the Tribulation.

First Sign: "... a great rebellion against God ..." (v 3a)

Second Sign: "...the man of lawlessness is revealed..." (v 3b)

What the man of lawlessness will do.

"He will exalt himself ..." (v 4a)

"... [He will] defy everything that people call god and every object of worship ..." (v 4b)

"He will even sit in the temple of God, claiming that he himself is God." (v 4c)

The One holding back the man of lawlessness.

"And you know what is holding him back ..." (v 6a)

"... the Lord Jesus will kill him by the breath of His mouth and destroy him by the splendor of His coming." (v 8b)

The character and strategy of the man of lawlessness.

"This man will come to do the work of Satan ..." (v 9a)

"... [he will] fool those on their way to destruction ..."

(v 10a)

"So God will cause them to be greatly deceived, and they will believe these lies." (v 11)

"Then they will be condemned for enjoying evil rather than believing the truth." (v 12)

Two instructions for believers.

First: "... stand firm..." (v 15b)

Second: "... keep a strong grip on the teaching we passed on to you..." (v 15c)
